Indian Scholarships for Tanzanian Students for the year 2010-2011

As in past years, Government of India scholarships will be available to Tanzanian students for studies in India for the academic session 2010-2011.

Administered by the High Commission of India, on behalf of Indian Council for Cultural Relations (ICCR) **18 scholarships**, will be available for Tanzania as per following details:

1. **Eight (8)** scholarship under Indian-Africa Forum Summit Scheme
2. **Six (6)** scholarship under the General Cultural Scholarship Scheme
3. **Three (3)** scholarship under the Commonwealth Scholarship/Fellowship Plan.
4. **One (1)** scholarship under the special Indian Scholarship Scheme to mark the 'Africa Day' in the memory of (Late) Dr. Amilcar Cabral.

Terms and Conditions. The above scholarships, inter alia, include monthly living allowance, contingency grants, accommodation charges, tuition fees, medical benefits, study tours expenses, thesis and dissertation expenses as applicable. Awardees of scholarship under the **Commonwealth Scholarship/Fellowship Plan, and Africa Day Scholarship Scheme**, will be **entitled to return airfare** in addition to the above. **MBBS/BDS courses are not covered by the scheme.**

Interested Tanzanian nationals who have fluent knowledge of English language, in written and spoken are invited to send their applications on plain paper giving relevant particulars including full residential address, email address and contact telephone number(s) as well as details of their educational qualifications, courses sought and universities/institutions desired/along with alternatives, and a short resume, to the High Commission of India, 82, Kinondoni Road, Kinondoni, PO Box 2684, Dar es Salaam (contact person: Mr. Sanjeev Manchanda, Attache(Edu), (Tel.
